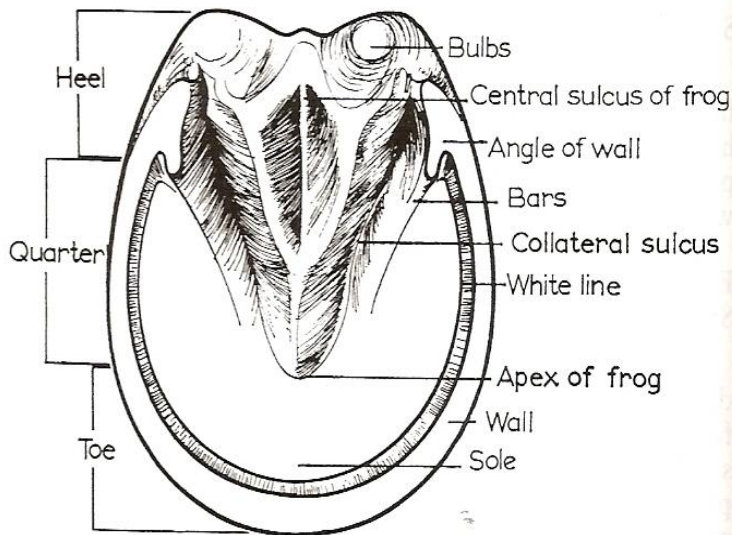


Figure 2.37 Normal forefoot showing structures.
